The **Inglis Broodmare Sale** was a mixed bag of mares and weanlings with the nicer ones selling well and the average ones again struggled. The upcoming **Magic Millions** sale looks a lot stronger on paper and I expect it to produce some fireworks in all areas. Yarraman has a strong draft of mares with quite a few really top class mares as well as five nice weanlings.

The **Scone Cup** meeting was a great success with a record turnover on both days and great crowds enjoyed really competitive racing with the prize money spread evenly between country and metropolitan stables. The exciting result for Yarraman was **Flippant** impressively winning the listed Woodlands Stakes on the Saturday becoming Hinchinbrook's first stakes winner and a very promising filly now on her way to Brisbane. Yarraman bought the filly last year at

the Magic Millions sale and syndicated her amongst a great bunch of friends.
