We are delighted with the stallions and to have **Hinchinbrook** leading 1st Season Sire and **I Am Invincible** going from strength to strength is very satisfying for all of us on the farm.

Hinchinbrook had a small foal crop in his first year and to get a colt like **Press Statement** and a filly as promising as **Flippant** augers very well for his future.

I Am Invincible continues to amaze us. He is neck and neck with Snitzel in 2YO list with 21 2YO winners. He is 3rd on the 3YO Sires table behind only Fastnet Rock and Street Cry. He has the best sprinting 3YO in the Country and maybe the best sprinter in Brazen Beau.

Brazen Beau has done him proud in England and I thought his run in the G1 Diamond Jubilee was sensational, to come up that straight on his own and just get run down was a testament to his courage and adaptability.

I Am Invincible's books get better every year and it is so exciting thinking about the mares foaling to him and his book this year. His record compares to Australia's best stallions and he's done it from a low fee and really only the support of many smaller breeders.

Magic Albert is having another good season and never stops producing good racehorses.

Mawaakib looks a very promising horse in the Hawkes Stable and Alberto Magic is stringing together a good record.

Magic Albert has been a fantastic stallion for Yarraman and with his fee reduced to \$11K he is a horse people can breed to with confidence that the market will like them. He's the Sire of 5 Group 1 Winners, not many sires achieve that.

There are so many nice horses heading to the spring races either by our stallions or bred at Yarraman, that it is a really exciting time for the farm. Also looking at the quality of mares to foal down the future looks bright.

The whole aim of breeding to us, is to breed high class horses and to have 3 stallions firing makes the job a lot easier.
